1000 CLUB NEWS

As we approach the completion of the third year of Our Lady's 1000 Club, we want to thank you for your continued support. The renewal letters have been sent out for our February renewals. OUR LADY’S ACADEMY NEWS

This November the students from Our Lady’s Academy who had been placed in the advanced math classes for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade took part in a national mathematics competition. The American Mathematics Competition has been taking place in classrooms across the country for over 60 years now. The AMC 8 is an eighth grade test which covers the entire middle school mathematics curriculum. Topics include estimation, percentages, probability, spatial reasoning, interpreting graphs, and everyday applications of mathematics.

The AMC results include a school team with a gold, silver, and bronze medal winner from the students who took part in the competition. Along with the school results, the AMC8 committee awards national recognition to those students whose scores are the highest in the country. Our Lady’s Academy school team includes the bronze medal winner, Lukas Marmaris. Our Silver Medalist was John Lee. These students are current members of the seventh grade class. The school’s gold medal was JunHo Park.

In addition to our school results, we had several students who were recognized for their national achievement. The first national award was received by Nicholas Wilson. Nicholas was recognized for his high achievement as a sixth grade student taking part in the competition. The next two awards were received by Lukas Marmaris and John Lee. Lukas and John were recognized for finishing in the top 5% of the country in the competition. Lastly, JunHo Park was awarded for his distinction of placing in the top 1% of the country. Congratulations are due for Nicholas, Lukas, John, and JunHo’s national distinction, and for all of our students who took part in the competition!
