Catechism Corner - St. Kateri Tekakwitha Kateri Tekakwitha, also known as the "Lily of the Mohawks," was a young Iroquois woman who lived in the 17th century. Child of a Mohawk father and a Christianized Algonquin mother, she was born in present day New York and was orphaned at age four by a smallpox epidemic. Due to the disease she faced challenges due to facial scars and impaired vision. She converted to Catholicism, faced opposition from her tribe, and dedicated her life to prayer and acts of service, eventually becoming the first Native American to be canonized by the Catholic Church. She was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1980. In December 2011, after evaluating the testimony of a young boy who claimed his infection with a flesh-eating bacteria disappeared after he prayed for her intercession, Pope Benedict XVI recognized her a saint. She was canonized the following October.
